PRESCHOOL Pre-K2 News from Ms. Bethany Malone, Mrs. Mary Schultz & Mrs. Ashley Smith: Hello PREK-2 Families!!! Welcome to September! We have high hopes for cooler weather and fall activities!! With the new month comes new exciting things to learn about! This month we will be introducing the color Yellow, the number 2, the letter B and the square! We have been working hard on learning "We Praise You, O God" and we cannot wait to share it with you this This week we introduced the 3rd Sunday! commandment, the 3rd line of the Lord's Prayer, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> line of Apostle's Creed. I sent home 10 Commandment family projects over the weekend and they are looking amazing! I love the family pictures while creating these projects and everyone did so great! Our theme this month is Adam and Eve. The Bible story I have chosen for this week will be "God Creates the World". PRESCHOOL Pre-K3 News from Ms. Martin & Mrs. Bezler: The week in Pre-K 3 we are reviewing the letters S, A, and working on letter L. We are continuing to review numbers 3 & 5 and making groups of objects big and little. The kiddos have been working on their building skills with a variety of blocks of different shapes and sizes. The Bible story this week is out the Children's Bible 'The Beginning'. We have been discussing what God created for us the first 6 days. With our letter L we are expressing that God gave us Light and that we can keep it bright with our prayers and following the faith. Each day we continue to work on our fine motor skills, as well as our social and emotional skills with each other. A couple of reminders; that the Scholastic Book Order Forms that went home have on-line as well and I will be finalizing the order On Friday the 6th. There will be new book orders throughout the year. Also, the kids have all been working on our song for church this coming Sunday the 8th. PRE-SCHOOL Pre-K4 News from Ms. Candy West & Mrs. Khristina Seaton: In the pre-K 4 classroom this week we are working on student's first names, letters, Cc plus reviewing Aa and Bb. Our journey with numbers continues by adding the number 5 while reviewing numbers 1 through 4. Shapes and colors are entering our lessons. Our friends know their circles, squares, rectangles, and triangles... So, we will begin to work with ovals, hexagons, and pentagons. A dual theme of welcome back to school and one of endurance which is a theme for the school this year was welcomed by the students with the thought of," if Jesus could do it, endure the human experience and crucifixion, then we should try hard every day to help ourselves and others make it to the finish line". Our classroom rules have helped us with that theme and one of our social and emotional books of being polite and kind was another way that we've been focusing on these themes. For the month of September, we will be thinking about who we are and the family tree project will help us get a good start with that. We are still working on our 10 Commandments and the students have learned the third one, we will review it and start commandment number four next week. We have chosen the Bible story of Adam and Eve to highlight for the month of September. We will also be taking trips to the Public Library this month!

<u>Kindergarten - 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade News from Mrs. Deborah</u> Steinacher: For the week of Sept. 9, we will be working on learning Psalm 146:1-5 for memory. In religion we will be learning about Joseph and how God can make good things happen in bad times. In reading and spelling we will be on unit 1.4. While we are reading, we will look for our sight words, vocabulary words, the main characters, and is the story fiction or nonfiction. In math we will be working online segments, shapes, trading pennies for a dime, and making patterns. We will also be measuring length, identifying pairs, and reading a Venn diagram and pictographs. In social studies we are continuing to learn how we can be good citizens in our community. In science we have been learning about the stages of life. Now we will be looking at things in our habitat such as types of homes, jobs and places, and plants and animals. We would like to thank Kevyn for providing our snack break for the week in the afternoon. Thank you from all of us! Be sure to mark your calendar for Sept. 8. In the morning, we sing at Salem. Please arrive at 8:45 and go to the cafeteria. After the students sing, they will sit with their parents.
