Message from the Principal

To wrap up our Lenten theme of repentance, let's talk baptism. We read in Romans 6: "Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, in order that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." This is not a reward for the worthy but a gift for the broken. Repentance is not proving we belong in God's presence. It's admitting that we need what only God can give. To repent is not to say I'm fine now. It is to say I need a Savior. In baptism, God joins us to Christ's death, so that everything that was killing us is carried by Him. He joins us to Christ's resurrection, so that a new life is open to us, not someday, but right now. In baptism, God takes responsibility for your life, names you His own, forgives you of your sins and failures and gives you a new way forward.
