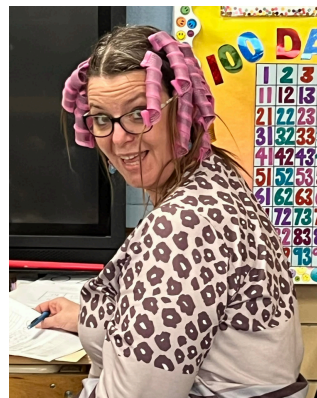
Salem's Annual Action
